Pray

As we confirmed with God his calling to start a new church, I had to know why. I had questions. God, it seems like we have churches all over the place...why plant a new one? What do we call it?

God led me to a few places to give me answers. My first place to turn was Gods Word...i went to Paul's letter to churches.

Ephesians 1.18-19 I I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened so that you may know what is the hope of his calling, what is the wealth of his glorious inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the mighty working of his strength.

Colossians 1.4-6 l ⁴ for we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all the saints ⁵ because of the hope reserved for you in heaven. You have already heard about this hope in the word of truth, the gospel ⁶ that has come to you. It is bearing fruit and growing all over the world, just as it has among you since the day you heard it and came to truly appreciate God's grace

Out of this, I felt City Hope was the name God was impressing on my soul for this new work.

Ok I got the name...but why? The answer to the question of why...came in a different way. I read these 2 quotes that just stuck.

"Jesus is the hope of the world, and the local church is the vehicle of expressing that hope to the world." - Andy Stanley

"The world needs more Christians, and the world needs better Christians." – James McDonald

These things combined gave us the calling and confidence to step out in faith and go all in.

With all of this in mind our mission statement was born...To invite everyday people to experience the hope of Jesus in every way.

We feel like this encompasses both angles of a Christians life...I want you to personally experience Jesus, and I want you to invite others to experience Jesus.

I whole-heartedly feel that if we are living by this...we are on mission for God.

Sidenote: Lots of Christians are good with the me experiencing Jesus part but forget about the inviting other's part. We'll talk more about that in the coming weeks.

The Big Vision

Some of you are visual learners, so let me show you. (Show 6 slides of future building)

I see a campus that is a daily ministry hub. (Counseling center, Child-care center, Pregnancy Crisis, life-skills center, sports ministry that includes fields and gymnasiums, etc.

When I start dreaming and thinking about this.... I get excited! I want it now! Let's go God.

With all of this in mind I've spent a lot of time praying and begging God to show us our next steps.

This past summer...He did. And it wasn't the answer I was expecting.

Disclaimer: I'm very cautious to play the God card. You can ask our team...I need God to double, and triple tell me something before I say, "God told me."

What do I need to do to make this vision happen? His answer...slow down.

Slow down????? Why? – There is no need to build a big building to get more people if you can't take care of the people, I've already given you.

What in the world does that mean?

- 1. Shepherd who I have given you
- 2. Strengthen your foundation

Then he directed me to what God told the prohet Habakkuk.

Habakkuk 2.2-4 l ² The Lord answered me: Write down this vision; clearly inscribe it on tablets so one may easily read it. ³ For the vision is yet for the appointed time; it testifies about the end and will not lie. Though it delays, wait for it, since it will certainly come and not be late.

In other words, the vision is coming. Do your job to be ready for when it comes.

Our job...shepherd who I have given you and strengthen your foundation. That's exactly what we are going to do.

How? (3 areas we will focus on.)

- 1. Biblical Counseling (The Hope Center)
- 2. Kids Ministry
- 3. Student Ministry

In order to get here...it takes a financial investment. This is where **The Hope Project** kicks in.

The Hope Project is our campaign to raise the necessary funds to accomplish Gods mission for City Hope Church.

(Show Slide 59 from Canva) Our Pastoral team along with our finance team sat down and estimated this vision would take an investment of \$1.3 million dollars.

Some of you may be thinking...that's a lot of money. You're right, but I want to show you how big God is.

\$597,800 – Savings and pledges from leaders. \$416,400 – Value of facility gift \$1,014,200 – Total raised to date
